(MEXICO) - The Audrain County Health Department, along with the Mexico Area Family YMCA, the Missouri National Guard and nearly 20 other Audrain County entities, hosted a mass vaccination clinic in Mexico yesterday (Tuesday). The final tally of those receiving their first dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine at this clinic came in at 481. They will return for their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of the vaccine at the YMCA in Mexico on April 27<sup>th</sup>.

“We are pleased with that number,” ACHD Administrator and CEO Craig Brace said. “While some may believe it to be a low number, we are looking at it as a positive because that is telling us that other Audrain County and area residents are finding other avenues to receive their vaccines.”

Brace said this was another example of entities working together to make it happen for the good of Audrain County.

“We are amazed at how seamlessly different entities in the county came together to help support our mission,” he said. “From the YMCA offering their building to a local nursing home providing lunch sandwiches for our workers, we couldn’t be more grateful. Truly, thanks to everyone involved in making these clinics as successful as they were. We couldn’t have done it without them.”
